### **RULE CHANGES**

Leinster League committee are proposing the following rule changes:

**RULE 2:** To read as follows:

The League shall be open for membership to teams, which consist of players affiliated to the Leinster Branch of the Irish Table Tennis Association C.L.G. The affiliation fees to be collected by the Leinster League and paid to the I.T.T.A.

**RULE 5(m):** To read as follows:

Where a Club is not represented at the Annual General Meeting in each year a fine of €30 shall be imposed on it.

**RULE 6(d):** To read as follows:

Accompanied by a fee of €20. The rest of that rule remains the same.

**RULE 7(g):** To read as follows:

A match shall consist of the best of five games and played up to eleven in each game. The rest of that rule remains the same.

**RULE 7(j):** To read as follows:

All League fixtures, with the exception of divisional play-offs, must be played by a date fixed by the committee.

**RULE 8(b):** To read as follows:

A Cup fixture must be played to a finish at the first attempt, with a deciding doubles to be played in the event of a draw, such doubles to be decided simultaneously before commencement of deciding doubles.

**RULE 8(c):** To read as follows:

All Cup finals shall be played at a venue decided by the committee and played to a finish at the first attempt.

**RULE 8(d):** To read as follows:

All Cup fixtures, with the exception of the finals, must be played by a date fixed by the committee.

**RULE 9(b):** To read as follows:

The further registration of players may be made during the season which shall be at the discretion of the committee. The rest of that rule remains the same.

**RULE 11:** To read as follows:

Protests must be sent in writing to the Hon. Secretary of the League, within three days of the alleged infringement giving rise to the protest, accompanied by a fee of €20 to be returned only if the protest is deemed reasonable.

You are reminded that non – attendance at this meeting incurs a fine of €30.
